In order to get started, there are a few things you need to know:

System Requirements

To access the Saint Francis Hospital wireless network, you will need:

- A laptop, PDA, or other wireless-enabled device with an Internet browser
- An installed wireless (WiFi) card
- A proper operating system, Windows XP or newer

Getting Connected

- Power up the computer or wireless-enabled device
- Click the “Start” button
- From the “Start” menu, choose the “Control Panel” option
- Select the “Network and Internet” option
- Select “Guestaccess”
- “Guestaccess” window will pop up, click “Connect”
- Unsecured warning will appear at the bottom of the screen. Click “Connect” to proceed accessing the Saint Francis Hospital wireless network
- Receive message, “Successfully Connected to Guestaccess”
- Click Internet browser icon and begin surfing the web!
